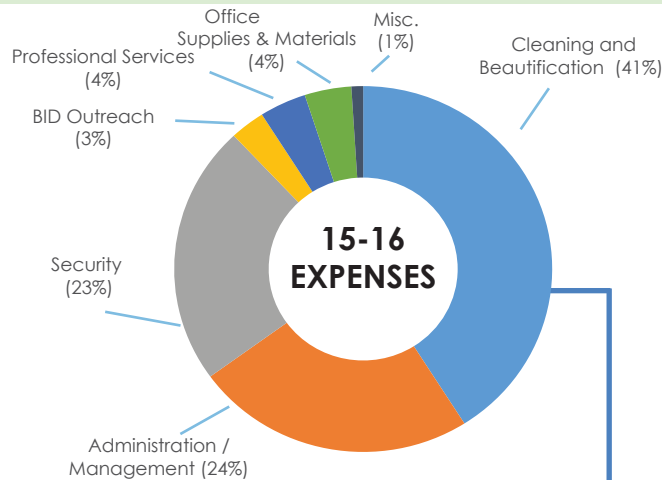

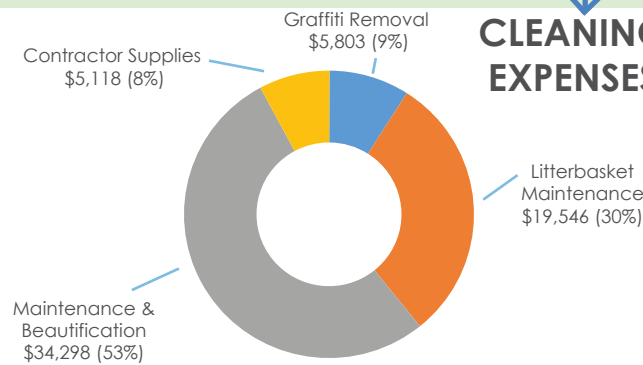

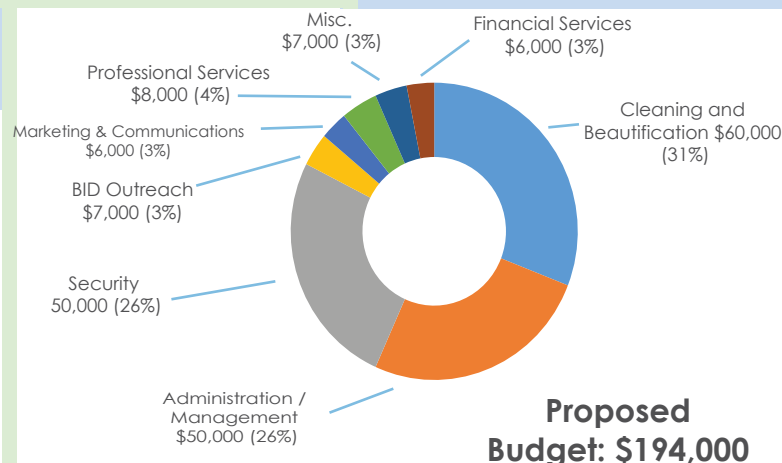

WHAT IS A BID?

"BID" stands for Business Improvement District. The West Vernor & Springwells BID maintains, improves and enhances the shopping district to create a clean, comfortable and secure place for residents, customers and visitors to enjoy.

The property owners in the BID pay a yearly fee to help pay for BID services. Property owners elect a Board of Directors who determine cost-effective ways of investing BID funds to create visible positive change in the business district.





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NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS

The BID Board of Directors' meeting is the 3rd Thursday of every month at 9:00 a.m. Meeting notices of dates, times and locations are posted at the Southwest Detroit Business Association office, the Springwells Station Post Office, and the Detroit Public Library Campbell Branch. All meetings are open to the public. Business and property owners are encouraged to attend.

The BID Annual Property Owners' Meeting is held in the first quarter of the BID fiscal year, normally in September. Please call to verify meeting location, date and time.

WEST VERNOR & SPRINGWELLS BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT SERVICES, 2015-16

In an effort to increase property values, improve sales at area businesses, assist business and property owners, and make the corridor a more inviting space for customers, visitors, and residents, the BID provides a number of services. During the 15-16 fiscal year, the BID provided a range of services, including:

• **Police Patrols:** BID-contracted off-duty Detroit Police Department officers patrolled the BID three days a week, totaling more than 604 contracted hours of patrols. Typical patrol hours are: Fridays 8pm-12am, and Saturdays 9pm-1am, though the times change. BID members can reach the officers at 313.844.3978 daytime and 313.433.4616 night-time.

• **Bike Watch:** In early 2015, the BID established a partnership with the Americorps Urban Safety Project (AMUS) Bike Watch program at Wayne State University. For a nominal fee, Bike Watch is able to provide three bicycle patrols for a total of six hours per week throughout the spring, summer, and fall. In 2016, Bike Watch was able to complete more than 40 patrols and 253 visits to BID businesses.

• **Clean Team:** Private, BID-funded contractors picked up litter and swept the sidewalk and curbs three days per week, picking up 27,000 gallons of litter and sweeping more than 733 miles of curbs and sidewalks. Clean Team staff also removed more than 20 illegal dumping sites. BID members may arrange removal by calling the BID at 313.842.0986 x1009.

• **Graffiti Removal:** The BID hired private contractors to remove more than 321 graffiti tags on more than 163 buildings through power washing and painting. In the last five years the BID has reduced graffiti by 90%. BID members can arrange for graffiti removal by calling the BID at 313.842.0986 x1009.

• **Litterbaskets:** The BID maintains 88 litterbaskets, hauling away more than 153, 792 gallons of trash. BID litterbaskets are emptied each week.

BID Green Light Matching Grant Program

In mid 2016, the W Vernor & Springwells BID launched the Project Green Light Matching Grant Program to help business and property owners join a ground-breaking crime-fighting partnership called Project Green Light, which gives businesses real-time high-quality camera connections to police headquarters. The matching grant program from the BID reimburses business owners up to half of their costs in getting the equipment needed to join the program. Cricket Wireless, Paul's Pizza, and Sherry's on Vernor were the first businesses to join the program and install the equipment. Several more businesses will be joining Project Greenlight this winter, and the BID is still accepting new applicants.
